Psalm 23 (ESV) – A *PSALM OF DAVID.*

¹The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.

²He makes me lie down in green pastures.

He leads me beside still waters.

³He restores my soul.

*He leads me in paths of
righteousness for His name's
sake.*

*⁴Even though I walk through the
valley of the shadow of death, I
will fear no evil, for You are with
me;*

*Your rod and your staff, they
comfort me.*

***5 You prepare a table before me in
the presence of my enemies;
You anoint my head with oil; my
cup overflows.***

***6 Surely goodness and mercy shall
follow me all the days of my life,
and I shall dwell in the house of
the LORD forever.***

**1. Your host offers you
real life.**

***V. 5: You prepare a table before
me in the presence of my
enemies.***

**Revelation 19:6–9 (CSB) - *Then I heard something like the voice of a vast multitude, like the sound of cascading waters, and like the rumbling of loud thunder, saying, “Hallelujah, because our Lord God, the Almighty, reigns!
7Let us be glad, rejoice, and give***

him glory, because the marriage of the Lamb has come, and his bride has prepared herself. ⁸She was given fine linen to wear, bright and pure. For the fine linen represents the righteous acts of the saints.

⁹Then he said to me, “Write:

Blessed are those invited to the marriage feast of the Lamb!” He also said to me, “These words of God are true.”

Revelation 3:20 (CSB) – “See! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and eat with him, and he with Me.”

**2. Your host enables
personal
transformation.**

V. 5 – *You anoint my head with oil.*

**1 Samuel 16:11–13 (CSB) –
*Samuel asked him, “Are these all
the sons you have?”***

***“There is still the youngest,” he
answered, “but right now he’s
tending the sheep.” Samuel told
Jesse, “Send for him. We won’t
sit down to eat until he gets
here.”*** ¹²***So Jesse sent for him.***

He had beautiful eyes and a healthy, handsome appearance. Then the LORD said, “Anoint him, for he is the one.”¹³ So Samuel took the horn of oil and anointed him in the presence of his brothers, and the Spirit of the LORD came powerfully on David from that day forward. Then

*Samuel set out and went to
Ramah.*

**2 Corinthians 1:21–22 (CSB) -
*Now it is God who strengthens
us together with you in Christ,
and who has anointed us. ²²He
has also put his seal on us and
given us the Spirit in our hearts
as a down payment.***

Galatians 5:22–23 (CSB) - *But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³gentleness, and self-control.*

James 4:8 (CSB) - *Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you.*

**3. Your host reassures
you of His affection.**

V. 5 – *My cup overflows.*”

Jeremiah 29:11 (CSB) - *For I know the plans I have for you”—this is the LORD’s declaration—“plans for your well-being, not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope.*

Matthew 6:25–34 (CSB) -

***“Consider the birds of the sky:
They don’t sow or reap or gather
into barns, yet your heavenly
Father feeds them. Aren’t you
worth more than they?”***

Isaiah 43:4 – *You are precious in my eyes, and honored, and I love you.*

Romans 8:35–39 (CSB) - *Who can separate us from the love of Christ? Can affliction or distress or persecution or famine or nakedness or danger or sword? ...³⁷No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us.³⁸For I am persuaded that neither death nor*

life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, ³⁹nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Zephaniah 3:17 – The Lord your God is in your midst, a mighty one who will save; he will rejoice over you with gladness; he will quiet you by his love; he will exult over you with loud singing.
