(Isaiah 6:5)

**Isaiah 6:5 (ESV) - *And I said:
“Woe is me! For I am lost; for I
am a man of unclean lips, and I

unclean lips; for my eyes have
seen the King, the LORD of
hosts!”***

**4. In real worship the
guilt of our sin is
gone.**

(Isaiah 6:6-7)

Isaiah 6:6-7 (ESV) - *Then one of the seraphim flew to me, having in his hand a burning coal that he had taken with tongs from the altar. ⁷And he touched my mouth and said: “Behold, this has touched your lips; your guilt is taken away, and your sin atoned for.”*

Matthew 27:46 (ESV) - *And about the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, “Eli, Eli, lema sabachthani?” that is, “My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?”*

(Isaiah 6:8)
