# **1. Shepherding: Aquila & Priscilla**

**DEFINITION: “*the ability of a pastor or a layperson to care for a specific group of Christians by guiding, nurturing, and protecting them.*”**

**Romans 16:3–5a (CSB) - *Give my greetings to Prisca and Aquila, my coworkers in Christ Jesus, <sup>4</sup>who risked their own necks for my life. Not only do I thank them, but so do all the Gentile churches. <sup>5</sup>Greet also the church that meets in their home.***



**Acts 18:2–3 (CSB) - *He found a Jew named Aquila, a native of Pontus, who had recently come from Italy with his wife Priscilla because Claudius had ordered all the Jews to leave Rome. Paul came to them,<sup>3</sup> and since they were of the same***

***occupation, tentmakers by trade,  
he stayed with them and worked.***

**Acts 18:24–26 (CSB) - *Now a Jew named Apollos, a native Alexandrian, an eloquent man who was competent in the use of the Scriptures, arrived in Ephesus.***  
***<sup>25</sup>He had been instructed in the way of the Lord; and being fervent in spirit, he was speaking and***

***teaching accurately about Jesus, although he knew only John's baptism. <sup>26</sup>He began to speak boldly in the synagogue. After Priscilla and Aquila heard him, they took him aside and explained the way of God to him more accurately.***

***him. After he arrived, he was a great help to those who by grace had believed. <sup>28</sup>For he vigorously refuted the Jews in public, demonstrating through the Scriptures that Jesus is the Messiah.***

# **3. Administration: Philip the Apostle**

**DEFINITION: “*the ability to plan and coordinate the gifts and talents of a group of Christians to reach certain objectives.*”**

**1 Corinthians 12:28 (CSB) - *And God has appointed these in the church: first apostles, second prophets, third teachers, next miracles, then gifts of healing, helping, administrating, ...***



**John 6:3–7 (CSB) - *Jesus went up a mountain and sat down there with his disciples. <sup>4</sup>Now the Passover, a Jewish festival, was near. <sup>5</sup>So when Jesus looked up and noticed a huge crowd coming toward him, he asked Philip, “Where will we buy***

*bread so that these people can eat?”<sup>6</sup> He asked this to test him, for he himself knew what he was going to do.*

*<sup>7</sup>Philip answered him, “Two hundred denarii worth of bread wouldn’t be enough for each of them to have a little.”*
